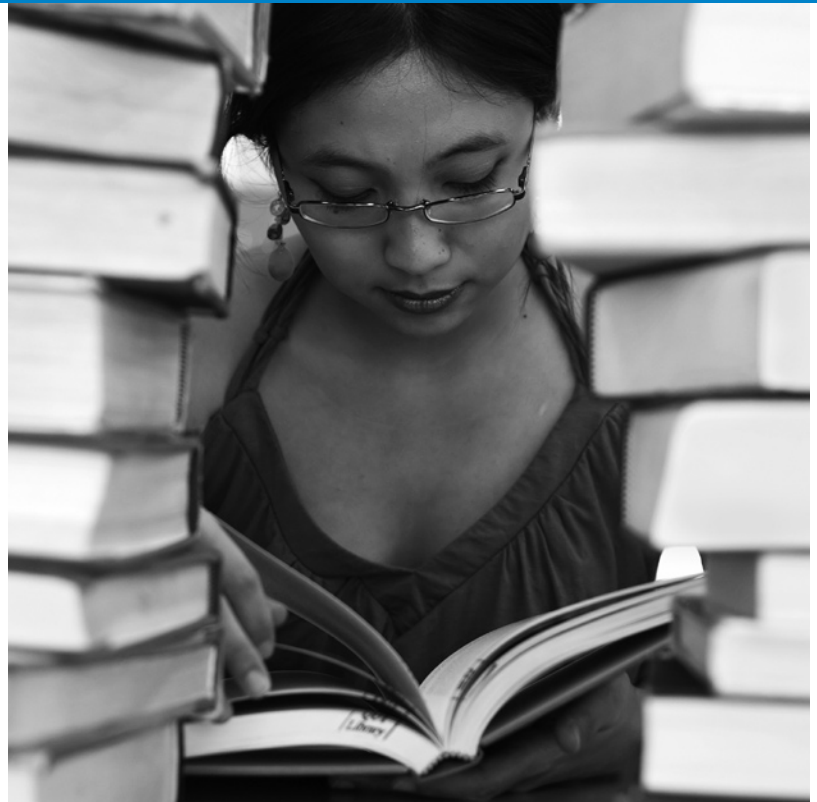

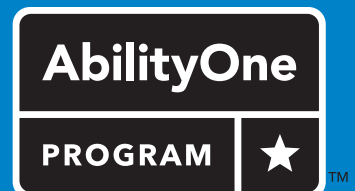


One of the 2010 NISH Leader's Book Clubs is a must for senior or aspiring executives!

Purpose:

The NISH Academy is pleased to; once again, offer the Leader's Book Clubs for CRPs. The book clubs are designed to expand the knowledge of senior managers and to develop new leaders.

The Leader's Book Clubs provide an excellent venue for continuing professional growth; which is crucial to continued success. They offer forums for examining new ideas and strategies and for discussing concepts and sharing ways to apply lessons learned.

Audience:

The two (2) book clubs are Advanced and Emerging. The Advanced Leader's Book Club is appropriate for CEOs, Executive Directors, and other upper-level management staff. Organizational leadership is the focus of the books for this club.

The Emerging Leader's Book Club is appropriate for new managers. The books focus on issues of interest to rising executives who seek to hone individual leadership skills.

Format:

The two book clubs meet once a month for six months. Participants read one new book per month and participate in a one-hour, facilitated group discussion via conference call. The cost of the books and conference calls are covered by NISH. Participants buy the books and NISH reimburses them after they have met the attendance criteria. Participants must attend at least five of the six discussions to be reimbursed for all books purchased for the book clubs. Please see the following page for the schedule and the book titles.

- Improve organizational leadership
- Improve management skills
- Apply new ideas to current challenges
- Share lessons learned and examine new strategies
- Network with peers and develop ongoing relationships to further leadership skills
